## ORDER

Comes now, the Shenandoah County Sheriff's Department and does hereby request release of Dustin Ray Stanley on the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Dustin Stanley, upon release from Jail, is ordered to cooperate with Law Enforcement and immediately take action in assisting Law Enforcement.
- 2. Dustin Stanley will maintain daily contact with either Inv. John Thomas or <u>Special Agent Eric Flagg (ATF)</u>, in person or telephonically.
- 3. Any monies compensated to Dustin Stanley for his cooperation with Law Enforcement will be directly paid by Law Enforcement to the Shenandoah County Juvenile and Domestic Relations Court to be applied toward the arrearage owed by Dustin Stanley.
- 4. Within twelve (12) months of release and satisfaction of his jail sentence, Dustin Stanley is to enlist in a branch of the U.S. Military.
- 5. If at any time Dustin Stanley fails to contact Law Enforcement, violates the law or violates any other condition imposed, he will immediately surrender himself to the Sheriff of

Shenandoah County and be placed back in jail to serve the remainder of his sentence.

6. Dustin Stanley is to reside with his mother/grandmother and if he moves to another location, prior to his move, must notify either Inv. John Thomas or Special Agent Eric Flagg or this will become a violation of the terms of his release and he will be remanded back to jail to serve the remainder of his sentence.

IT IS HEREBY ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED that Dustin Ray Stanley shall be released on his personal recognizance in order to adhere to the above stated conditions of release.
